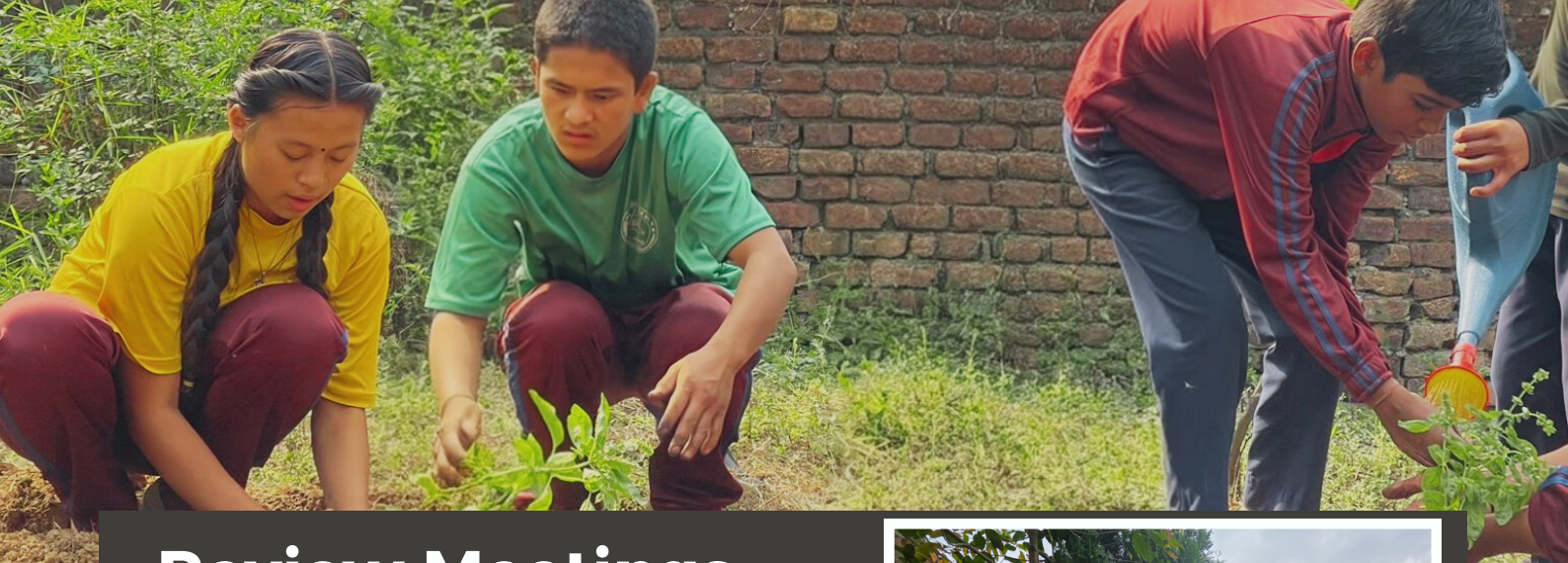




Review Meetings Spark Shared Commitment
