



SCHOOLS JOIN HANDS TO FIGHT CLIMATE CHANGE

In a recent Climate Change and Environment Awareness Campaign, held in Mahalaxmi Municipality, students from several schools came together to raise awareness about climate change and environmental care among the community. They promoted waste reduction by encouraging less plastic use and composting organic waste.

The campaign had a total of 170 participants, comprising 98 females and 72 males. Among them, 14 volunteers from St. Xavier's College participated through their connection with the USMN (Universal Solidarity Movement Nepal) club.

The participants represented diverse ethnic groups, including 54 Brahmin/Chhetri, 81 Janajati, 18 Dalit and 17 from other ethnic backgrounds, ensuring inclusivity.
